BIBLE FOUNDATIONS LESSON NO. 5

PHYSICAL HEALING

The stripes that Jesus bore just before going to the Cross tell us that His atonement for our sins included healing for our bodies (1 Pet. 2:24; Isa. 53:5). It is recorded many times in the Gospels that Jesus went about healing all those who were sick, and this included every kind of sickness and disease (Matt. 4:23-24). He came to redeem us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us (Gal. 3:13). We read in Psalm 105:37 that, when God led the children of Israel out of Egypt, there was not one feeble person among their tribes. How much greater are God's promises to us today through His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ! The Old Covenant was merely a shadow of things to come, but we are part of the "better covenant," which was established upon better promises (Heb. 8:5-6).

Healing is ours to claim by faith, as we hear and believe the Word of God. We may then reach out to 'touch Him' for our healing, even as all who touched the hem of Jesus' garment were made perfectly whole (Matt. 14:36). Faith is very important to us, because *"...without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him"* (Heb. 11:6). We receive by asking God to meet our needs, and we please Him by believing His Word that our prayers will be answered. One of the greatest sins is unbelief (John 3:36); therefore, we must believe that we already have the petitions that we desire of Him (1 John 5:15). We must humbly cry out to God as did the father of the demon possessed child when he said with tears, *"...Lord, I believe, help thou mine unbelief"* (Mark 9:24). We are told in Romans 10:17 how to receive faith: *"So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."*




